 - e. Ernest Fukumoto's QiGong training was certified by the Wei-Tuo Foundation, a QiGong training institute founded under the direction of Master Situ Jie, 10th heir of the Wei Tuo QiGong Lineage of China.
3. Client/Student expressly acknowledges and agrees that the terms of this agreement represents the full and complete understanding of the relationship between Ernest Fukumoto and Client/Student.
